- Applicant must submit a Diagnosis Letter
- Applicant must reside in the Washington Metropolitan "DMV" Area
- Applicant must be in the graduating class of 2020.
- Applicant must have a minimum GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
- Applicant must show demonstrated leadership ability in the school and community.

The Kozy Kerchief and Kozy Kap Scholarship is meant to offset the cost of tuition, books, and other academic necessities for a graduating senior (U.S. citizens only) who will be a full time college student beginning Fall 2020.

Completed Applications include the following:

- Current official student transcript that includes the most recent grades
- Two Letters of Recommendation- One must be from a counselor or teacher
- Documentation of Diagnosis
- Parental/Guardian Contact Information
- 200-250 Word Essay Response
- **Prompt**
 - **How has a cancer diagnosis affect your life, values, and/or career goals?**

Awards will be disbursed directly to the college or university in August 2020. Funds may be applied to offset books and other academic supplies.
